

# ONE Day Celebration - 28th August 2021

## Covid-19 Advice & Measures As at 9th July 2021

We are pleased to confirm that this year's event, the ONE Event - ONE Day Celebration will be going ahead as planned.

With the lifting of Government restrictions having taken place on the 19th July we felt it was important to update all of those involved in the event with what measures we are currently planning to have in place, but please be advised that all of this information is subject to change up until the day of the event as at any time government guidance may be updated.

### **Before attending the event**

#### We will

- Be carefully monitoring the pandemic, government advice and constantly reviewing our plans

#### We ask that you will

- Not attend if you show symptoms of COVID-19, or are instructed to self isolate by NHS Test & Trace. You should follow all government advice at the time before attending the event
- Book in advance via our website or over the phone, this will not only speed up registration on the day but it also reduces unnecessary contact with our booking team.

#### We will give you the choice to

- Be vaccinated - It is not a requirement to be fully vaccinated to attend this event, and we will **not** be using the COVID-Pass system. However as per government advice we would encourage anyone able to be vaccinated to consider having a vaccine.
- Take a test - In line with best practice we would encourage everyone planning to attend to take a Lateral Flow Test before attending the event, this is not a requirement to attend, and you do **not** need to inform us of a negative result.

### **At the event - general**

#### We will

- Ask all our crew to wear a face covering while engaging with attendees - unless you state you are happy otherwise (please see our separate notes below on Children's venues)
- Put in place one-way systems and social distanced queueing where deemed necessary
- Ensure all indoor spaces are well ventilated and where possible activities are conducted outside
- Give attendees the option to sit social distanced by...

- Outside - we will have a limited amount of general seating for those who wish to use it, there will be sufficient space in the arena for those who would prefer their own space to bring chairs, picnic blankets e.t.c.
- We also have a special needs seating area which will include distanced seating, hearing loop, BSL Sign language (Main Sessions) and a designated space for Wheelchair users or those with restricted mobility
- Inside - providing the option for both general seating and distanced seating, subject to venue capacity limits.
- Be cleaning all toilet facilities regularly
- Install perspex screens at our information desk
- Provide sufficient hand sanitiser and hand washing facilities.

#### We ask that you will

- Bring a contactless method of payment with you instead of cash
- Remain in your car for registration
- Bring chairs or picnic blankets with you
- Stick to the same seating block for the entire day - If sitting in one of our General Seating areas you will notice that each block is colour coded, please try to stick to sitting in the same section for the entire day, these areas won't be allocated so you can still choose which block to sit in.
- Help our stewards keep you safe by keeping your belongings with you and placing all litter into one of the bins provided

#### We will give you the choice to

- Practice Social Distancing - our crew members will respect any individual's choice to follow social distancing. For crew members who wish to not be in close contact with others they will be provided a badge indicating so - please respect this and everyone's choice in this matter by...
  - Asking before initiating physical contact
  - Asking before sitting directly next to another household
  - Respecting other people's views
  - Giving others space in confined spaces or queues
- Use hand sanitiser on entry and exit to the event, and on entry and exit to any indoor space or outdoor activity, we also recommend you wash your hands regularly throughout the day.
- Check-in using test and trace - we will be registering all delegates for our own records as usual, however none of this information will be passed on to any other organisation. Should you wish to checkin for test and trace QR codes will be available to scan on entry to the event.
- Wear a face covering - There is no requirement to wear a face covering anywhere on site, however we would recommend that you wear one especially when using indoor/crowded spaces, queuing or in close contact with others from outside your household. We will ask you to wear a face covering when dropping off and collecting

children from venues and if you go forward for prayer ministry, this is to protect everyone involved in these processes which often involve close contact.

### **At the event - Children's Venues**

#### We will

- Ask our crew to wear face coverings when working on registration. Once children are registered we will give our crew members the choice to wear a face covering or not.
- Put in place one-way systems and social distanced queueing where deemed necessary
- Ensure all indoor spaces are well ventilated and where possible activities are conducted outside
- Be cleaning all toilet facilities regularly
- Provide sufficient hand sanitiser and hand washing facilities.
- Allocate your child to a designated team or group for all sessions (Goo 4-10's venue only)

#### We ask that you will

- Register your child online before the event where possible
- Wear a face covering when dropping off or registering children at the venue
- If you stay with your child (Tiny Treasures 0-4's venue only) give you the choice to wear your face covering once you are registered
- Take your child to the toilet and wash their hands before bringing them to the venue

#### We will give you the choice to

- Practice Social Distancing - our crew members will respect any individual's choice to follow social distancing when dropping off or collecting children. For crew members who wish to not be in close contact with others they will be provided a badge indicating so - please respect this and everyone's choice in this matter by...
  - Asking before initiating physical contact
  - Asking before sitting directly next to another household
  - Respecting other people's views
  - Giving others space in confined spaces or queues

#### We will not be

- Requiring or enforcing any child to distance from other children or crew members

### **At the event - Prayer Ministry**

#### We will

- Ask all our crew to wear a face covering while praying with you - unless you state you are happy otherwise
- Ensure our crew members ask before initiating physical contact including the laying on of hands
- Conduct prayer ministry to the side of the arena where sound levels will be lower reducing the need to raise voices or shout to communicate
- Provide sufficient hand sanitiser

- Provide a text number for persons who aren't comfortable receiving prayer in person to submit their requests

We ask that you will

- Wear a face covering when going to the ministry area for prayer, once paired with a prayer partner if you both agree you are happy to not wear masks these can be removed
- Ask before initiating physical contact

We will give you the choice to

- Practice Social Distancing - our crew members will respect any individual's choice to follow social distancing. For crew members who wish to not be in close contact with others they will be provided a badge indicating so - please respect this and everyone's choice in this matter by...
  - Asking before initiating physical contact
  - Asking before sitting directly next to another household
  - Respecting other people's views
  - Giving others space in confined spaces or queues
- Use hand sanitiser before and after being prayed for
